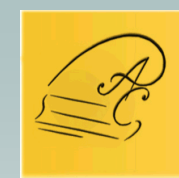

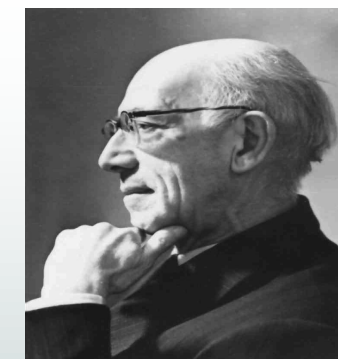

## COMPETITION RULES

1. The Fifth International Competition “Andrei Stoyanov” is open to all pianists of any age and nationality who study piano privately, at local music school, in a music program at their regular grade or high school, or at a specialized music institution (pre -college or collegiate), as long as piano is not their major instrument, or do not perform or teach piano on a professional basis.
  2. Date and location: The Fifth International Competition “Andrei Stoyanov” will take place November 22-25, 2018 in the concert hall of the “Andrei Stoyanov” Community and Music Center.
  3. The international jury includes well-known pianists and pedagogue from Bulgaria and abroad.
  4. Prizewinners of the first prize of previous edition of the competition will be not allowed to take part in the same group in actual edition.
  5. It is possible for a candidate to take part in a higher age group, presenting the repertoire and duration of the program with the requirements of the upper age group.
6. Competition Program:
- Piano solo:**
- a) obligatory piece from Andrei Stoyanov
  - b) free chosen works
- N.B. The pieces of the solo program could be played with a score.*
- Piano ensembles:**
- a) free chosen works
- N.B. The pieces from the ensemble program have to be played with a score.*
5. Awards: All the participants will receive diplomas for participation. The prize winners ( first, second and third prize) of each group will receive medal and non-cash prizes. The jury could give special prize for best performance of Andrei Stoyanov piece.

## COMPETITION GROUPS

### Piano solo:

- Group 1 Up to seven years old - (completed until 22.11.of 2018)  
Max. Timing - 5 min.
- Group 2 Up to 9 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018)  
Max. Timing - 8 min.
- Group 3 Up to 11 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018)  
Max. Timing - 10 min.
- Group 4 Up to 13 years old- ( completed until the end of 2016)  
Max. Timing - 12 min.
- Group 5 Up to 15 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018)  
Max. Timing - 15 min.
- Group 6A Up to 19 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018)\* for those who do not study at specialized music institutions  
Max. Timing - 17 min.
- Group 6B Up to 19 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018) for those who study at specialized music institutions, but not majoring in piano  
Max. Timing - 17 min.
- Group 7A Up to 25 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018)  
\* for those who do not study at specialized music institutions  
Max. Timing - 20 min.
- Group 7B Up to 25 years old- (completed until 22.11.of 2018)  
\*\* for those who study at specialized music institutions, but not majoring in piano  
Max. Timing - 20 min.
- Group 8 No age limit  
Max. Timing - 20 min.

### Piano ensembles:( two or more participants)- No age limit

The duration of the executed program - depending on the age of the performers, but not more than 15 minutes  
Participants in the piano ensembles could be of a different age.  
The duration could be LESS than the mentioned duration but **NOT LONGER**.

**In this 2018 the music world celebrates the following anniversaries:**

100 years from the death of Claude Debussy and 190 years from the death of Franz Schubert. Contestants may include optional in their freely chosen program works by composers already listed. The special prizes will be distributed for the best performance of their works.

## DOCUMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

- Special application form (*downloaded from site*)
- The completed application form must be accompanied by the following documents:
- Copy of birth certificate or passport for age verification;
  - a picture of the candidate in a good resolution
  - (for groups 2, 3, 4, and 5) an official school document attesting to what grade you are in)
  - (for candidates in groups 6A, 6B, 7, 8, ) copies of diplomas issued by each school from which you have graduated, demonstrating that you have not majored in piano.
